The intent and purpose is to help deserving students continue their education after high school graduation. The number and amount varies, with a minimum of one scholarship of \$1,000.00 awarded each year.

Deadline: April 1.

<u>Number Offered and Amount:</u> One award each year, with amount dependent upon the earnings gained from the investment of the bequest by the Clear Lake Community Schools (amount varies).

## Eligibility and Basis of Award:

- Must pursue a four year degree at an accredited college or university after graduating from Clear Lake High School.
- -- Selection will be completed by a committee consisting of an English teacher, history teacher, high school counselor, high school administrator, Marcia A. Connell, and Janet A. Connell Lovell.
- - The award recipient's name shall be engraved on an Esther Woodford Ashland award plaque and it will hang in the Clear Lake High School commons.
- -- Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- -- Must graduate from high school in the Clear Lake Community School District during the year of selection.
- -- Recipient must reside in the District for at least 2 years prior to graduation.
- -- Must not have been convicted of a felony or have a criminal record.
- -- Must be ranked in the upper half of the graduating class.
