

ESTHER WOODFORD ASHLAND SERVICE AWARD

This scholarship was established in memory of Esther W. Ashland and is awarded to a District student who believes education is a lifelong pursuit and service to others is an obligation. The intent and purpose is to help deserving students continue their education after high school graduation. The number and amount varies, with a minimum of one scholarship of \$1,000.00 awarded each year.

Deadline: April 1.

Number Offered and Amount: One award each year, with amount dependent upon the earnings gained from the investment of the bequest by the Clear Lake Community Schools (amount varies).

Eligibility and Basis of Award:

- Must pursue a four year degree at an accredited college or university after graduating from Clear Lake High School.
- Selection will be completed by a committee consisting of an English teacher, history teacher, high school counselor, high school administrator, Marcia A. Connell, and Janet A. Connell Lovell.
- The award recipient's name shall be engraved on an Esther Woodford Ashland award plaque and it will hang in the Clear Lake High School commons.
- Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- Must graduate from high school in the Clear Lake Community School District during the year of selection.
- Recipient must reside in the District for at least 2 years prior to graduation.
- Must not have been convicted of a felony or have a criminal record.
- Must be ranked in the upper half of the graduating class.
